ELIGIBILITY

1. Entrant must be a U. S. citizen and her guardian(s) must own/rent/lease property as their primary residence in Missouri or Johnson Country, Kansas.
2. Junior Age Limit: All girls through 17 years of age and 18 year old high school senior girls graduating by September 1.
3. Entries are subject to rejection at any time by the MWGA. The reason for rejection may include lack of attendance at the Mandatory Rules Seminar, unbecoming conduct or improper dress.
4. All contestants must adhere to the Amateur Code as specified by the USGA.

ENTRIES / WITHDRAWALS

1. **ENTRY DEADLINE: Wednesday June 1, 2011**
2. Each entry application and fee must reach the MWGA Junior Director, Nancy Sebastian, by the entry deadline.
3. All entries are subject to approval by the Board of Directors of the Missouri Women's Golf Association and the host Club/Course.
4. Entries shall be returned if not accompanied by an entry fee and a correctly completed entry.
5. The entry fee will be refunded, less a \$20 administrative fee, if withdrawal occurs prior to the entry deadline stated above, or if the field is full on the first day of play.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

1. A thirty-six (36) hole, stroke play competition. The two day low total from the Championship Tees will determine the Junior Champion. There will be a winner and runner-up in all age groups.
2. Age groups will be determined by birth date as of June 10, 2011. Any girl playing for the Championship Title must play from the Championship tees. (Apx. 6000 yards) Age groups may be flighted if a sufficient number of entries are received and will be determined after the first day scores.
3. Course Set Up by Flights:

4. Play is governed by the Rules of Golf as adopted by the USGA, and where applicable, by the Local Rules and consistent with those Rules.
5. **DRESS CODE: Norwood Hills Country Club's policy is that all skirts/skorts/shorts must be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee for participants and spectators. Shirts with a collar must be worn and tank tops or cropped shirts are not allowed. Athletic wear and denim are prohibited.**
6. Contestants must walk; contestants are not permitted to have a caddie. Rangefinders are not allowed.
7. In the event of inclement weather and the course is deemed unplayable USGA Rules of Golf 33-2d is in effect as well as the procedure in discontinuing and resuming play. Rule 6-8.

2. Practice rounds are encouraged Thursday June 2nd and Friday June 3rd the week prior to the championship. Please call Norwood Hills Pro Shop at 314-521-4802 and identify yourself as a MWGA participant. The practice round greens fee is \$ 15.
3. Please remember Norwood Hills Country Club insists participants/parents/spectators be dressed in shirts with a collar. Athletic attire or denim is not allowed. All skort/shorts must be no shorter than 4 inches above the knee for participants and spectators.
